

MEN'S ALL STAR SELECTION

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl at least one league in SSUSBC.
2. Six members will be selected to the All Star Team. A point system will be used as a guideline for the selection. Points are awarded in the following categories:
 - a. Top 5 averages out of each house. In the event of a tie for house average, points will be decided by taking the average out to decimal points
 - b. Top 8 averages in Bowlero Draft Classic. If all 5 high averages at Bowlero come from Bowlero Draft Classic (adjusted for sport conditions if applicable) no points will be awarded for the 5 high averages at Bowlero)
 - c. Top 8 averages in PBA Experience Draft. If all 5 high averages at Pacific come from PBA Experience Draft (adjusted for sport conditions if applicable) no points will be awarded for the 5 high averages at Pacific)
 - d. All Star points will be computed using the top 2 point totals from categories listed in section a, b and c.
 - e. All finalists at SSUSBC Masters & Tournament Players Championship.
 - f. Top 8 scratch All Events for SSUSBC Open Association Tournament
 - g. Top 5 scratch All Events for the SSUSBC Mixed Tournament
 - h. In the event of a tie for league average, points awarded will be decided by taking average out to decimal points.
 - i. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected.
3. Chairman of the All Star selection committee will be appointed by the South Sound USBC President. Members of the committee may consist of board and non-board members with an attempt to utilize current scratch bowlers and past All Star team members.
4. Cut off date for averages shall be March 14th and bowlers must have bowled a minimum of 2/3 of league schedule to that date.
5. Any senior bowler who may qualify for selection to both Regular and Senior All Star Teams shall bowl on the Regular All Star Team and the next person on the Senior All Star list will be on the team.
6. Those not selected to the team but who were high average in a bowling center, Master's winner, Open All Events Champion or high composite in the city will be recognized as being honorable mention.
7. To be given a separate inclusion in the individual awards, a house league must
 - a. have a sufficient number of high quality scratch bowlers to assure competitiveness for the special awards, and
 - b. apply to the All Star Selection Committee for special awards prior to October 1 of each season. The acceptance of this special award status and the number of points to be awarded shall be the sole discretion of the Committee. If special award status is granted to a house league, the remaining leagues in the house shall vie for the "House Average" awards found in 2a above.
