

## MEN'S ALL STAR SELECTION

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl at least one league in SSUSBC.
2. Six members will be selected to the All Star Team. A point system will be used as a guideline for the selection. Points are awarded in the following categories:
  - a. Top 5 averages out of each house. In the event of a tie for house average, points will be decided by taking the average out to decimal points
  - b. Top 8 averages in Paradise Draft Classic. If all 5 high averages at Paradise come from Paradise Draft Classic (adjusted for sport conditions if applicable) no points will be awarded for the 5 high averages at Paradise)
  - c. Top 8 averages in EQC Strike It Rich Draft. If all 5 high averages at Pacific come from EQC Strike It Rich Draft (adjusted for sport conditions if applicable) no points will be awarded for the 5 high averages at Pacific)
  - d. All Star points will be computed using the top 2 point totals from categories listed in section a, b and c.
  - e. All finalists at SSUSBC Masters
  - f. Top 8 scratch All Events for SSUSBC Open Association Tournament
  - g. Top 5 scratch All Events for the SSUSBC Mixed Tournament
  - h. In the event of a tie for league average, points awarded will be decided by taking average out to decimal points.
  - i. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected.
3. Chairman of the All Star selection committee will be appointed by the South Sound USBC President. Members of the committee may consist of board and non-board members with an attempt to utilize current scratch bowlers and past All Star team members.
4. Cut off date for averages shall be March 12th and bowlers must have bowled a minimum of 2/3 of league schedule to that date.
5. Any senior bowler who may qualify for selection to both Regular and Senior All Star Teams shall bowl on the Regular All Star Team and the next person on the Senior All Star list will be on the team.
6. Those not selected to the team but who were high average in a bowling center, Master's winner, Open All Events Champion or high composite in the city will be recognized as being honorable mention.
7. To be given a separate inclusion in the individual awards, a house league must
  - a. have a sufficient number of high quality scratch bowlers to assure competitiveness for the special awards, and
  - b. apply to the All Star Selection Committee for special awards prior to October 1 of each season. The acceptance of this special award status and the number of points to be awarded shall be the sole discretion of the Committee. If special award status is granted to a house league, the remaining leagues in the house shall vie for the "House Average" awards found in 2a above.

## SENIOR MEN'S ALL STAR

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl in at least 1 league in SSUSBC.
2. Must be 50 years of age by March 1, Super Seniors must be 65 by March 1. Super seniors will only bowl the home and home match with Seattle.
3. Six members will be selected to the All Star Team. A point system will be used as a guideline for the selection. Points are awarded in the following categories:
  - a. Top 5 averages in each house. In the event of a tie for house average, points will be decided by taking the average out to decimal points
  - b. Top 5 South Sound averages for all travel leagues which bowl in 6 or more centers. Travel leagues may include centers outside South Sound as long as at least 6 are within SSUSBC jurisdiction.
  - c. All Star points will be computed using the top 2 point totals from sections a and b.
  - d. Top 8 qualifying round scores in Senior Masters and Senior Scratch All Events in SSUSBC Open Tournament.
  - e. Top 5 Senior Scratch All Events in the SSUSBC Mixed Tournament.
  - f. In the event of a tie for league average, points awarded will be decided by taking the averages out to decimal point.
  - g. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected. Points will be awarded the same for Seniors and Super Seniors.
4. Chairman of the All Star selection committee will be appointed by the South Sound USBC President. Members of the committee may consist of board and non-board members with an attempt to utilize current scratch bowlers and past All Star team members.
5. Cut off date for averages will be March 12th and bowlers must have bowled a minimum of 2/3 of league schedule to that date.
6. Any senior member who qualifies for the Regular All Star team will be honored with selection to the Regular All Star Team and the number 7 senior on the list as compiled and chosen by the committee shall be chosen as a Senior All Star.
7. Those not selected to the team but who are high average in a house, Senior Master's winner or high Senior scratch All Events in South Sound Open Tournament will be recognized as honorable mention.
8. To be given a separate inclusion in the individual awards, a house league must
  - a. have a sufficient number of high quality scratch bowlers to assure competitiveness for the special awards; and
  - b. apply to the All Star Selection Committee for special awards prior to October 1 of each season. The acceptance of this special award status and the number of points to be awarded shall be in the sole discretion of the Committee. If special award status is granted to a house league, the remaining leagues in the house shall vie for the "House Average" awards found in paragraph 3a above.

## LADIES ALL STAR SELECTION

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl in at least 1 league in SSUSBC.
2. Six members will be selected to the All Star Team. The All Star team will be selected based on a point system. Points awarded in the following categories:
  - a. Top 5 averages in each house, in the event of a tie for house average, points will be decided by taking the average out to decimal points
  - b. Top 5 Sound Sound averages for all travel leagues which bowl in 6 or more centers. Travel leagues may include centers outside of South Sound as long as at least 6 are within SSUSBC jurisdiction.
  - c. All Star points will be computed using the top 2 point totals from the categories listed in sections a and b.
  - d. Top 8 places of the SSUSBC Ladies Classic
  - e. Top 8 Scratch All events in SSUSBC Women's Championship Tournament.
  - f. Top 5 Scratch All Events in SSUSBC Mixed Tournament.
  - g. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected.
3. Selection committee chairman will be appointed by South Sound USBC President and committee will consist of board and non-board members with an attempt made to utilize current scratch bowlers and past All Star team members.
4. Cut off date for averages will be March 12th and bowlers must have bowled a minimum of 2/3 of the league schedule to that date.
5. Any senior bowler who may qualify for both Regular and Senior All Star teams shall bowl on the regular All Star team.
6. Those not selected to the team but were high average in a house, Ladies Classic winner, Women's Scratch All Events winner will be recognized as honorable mention

## SENIOR LADIES ALL STAR

1. Must be a member of the South Sound USBC and bowl in at least 1 league in the SSUSBC and must be 50 years old by March 1.
2. Six members will be selected to the All Star Team. The All Star team will be selected based on a point system. Points awarded in the following categories:
  - a. Top 5 averages in each house, In the event of a tie for league average, points awarded will be decided by taking the average out to decimal points.
  - b. Top 5 South Sound averages for all travel leagues which bowl in 6 or more centers. Travel leagues may include centers outside South Sound as long as at least 6 are within SSUSBC jurisdiction
  - c. All Star points will be computed using the top 2 point totals from the categories listed in sections a.
  - d. Top 8 places in the Senior Division of the SSUSBC Ladies Classic Tournament
  - e. Top 8 Senior Scratch All Events in SSUSBC Women's Tournament.
  - f. Top 5 Senior Scratch All Events in SSUSBC Mixed Tournament.
  - g. In the event of a tie for selection to the team, the bowler with the highest composite average will be selected.
3. Selection committee chairman will be appointed by South Sound USBC President and committee will consist of board and non-board members with an attempt to utilize current scratch bowlers and past All Star Team members.
4. Cut off date for averages will be March 12th and bowlers must have bowled 2/3 of the league schedule to that date.
5. Any senior bowler who may qualify for the Regular All Star team will bowl on the Regular All Star Team and the next in line will be selected to the Senior All Star Team.
6. Those not selected to the team but were high average in a house, Scratch All Events winner, Ladies Classic winner will be recognized as honorable mention.
