

South Sound 2011-2012

**Youth All Star Selection**

- 1 Six young men and six young women will be selected to the South Sound Youth All Star Team. The All Star Selection Committee will be appointed by the youth Committee Chairperson. The South Sound Youth All Star Team will be determined by point system. Minimum average for girls is 150 and boys 175. Each member will receive a SMART scholarship (Act. #9009) once meeting all requirements of said team. The highest placing South Sound girl and boy in the Classic Masters Division I will be invited to practice with the All Star Team.
- 2 Youth bowlers must bowl in at least one league in the South Sound USBC jurisdictional area and be a member in good standing of USBC/SSUSBC. Bowlers may submit a league exemption request to the Youth Committee for consideration. Good standing shall mean current USBC membership and all league fees paid up to date. Youth under 18 years of age as of March 15, 2012 must have the parental permission portion of the All Star Agreement signed to participate in any matches or practices. If a bowler declines the position or consent is not provided the youth will be honored as an all star and the youth with the next highest point total will bowl.
- 3 Youth bowlers must have completed 2/3 of the league sessions in the league as of March 3, 2012. The High School Varsity Travel League will be considered as house averages and points awarded to their bowlers accordingly.
- 4 All Star Team members will be required to attend all team meetings. Practice sessions will be arranged to best accommodate all team members. Team members agree to participate in the Inter City All Star match, usually the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday and Thursday of May, and the Inter Association All Star Matches, usually the first weekend of June.
- 5 Youth coordinators must submit league averages as of March 3, 2012 by March 16, 2012.
- 6 A. House Averages: Points will be awarded to the top 5 averages from each bowling center and the travel league mentioned above. Only one house average shall be used for each bowler, highest point total from house level applied to bowler's all-star points.  
B. Tournament Points will be award for each of the following:
  - 1) Top five (5) scratch singles, doubles, team and all events scores in the South Sound USBC Youth Championship.
  - 2) Top sixteen (16) or first cut, whichever is less, in the SS Elimination - Div 1 & Junior Masters.
  - 3) Top five (5) individual series, boys & girls, for the South Sound Swiss and South Sound Holiday Fun.
  - 4) 5 points awarded to coronation qualifiers from the scratch divisions only, boys and girls, of the monthly King of the Hill. One time onlyC. Participation points awarded to those who participate in the South Sound Elimination – Div 1, Junior Masters, South Sound Swiss, South Sound USBC Youth Championship Tournament and South Sound Holiday Fun.
- 7 Team members will be required to conduct themselves in a manner that would not be considered derogatory to the sport of bowling or unacceptable bowling etiquette. **FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY AFFECT YOUR PARTICIPATION IN ANY OR ALL ALL-STAR MATCHES**
- 8 Team members may be required to help fund the costs of the All Star Events through fund raising or participation fees. Efforts will be made to keep the team members financial responsibility to a minimum.

**Tournament Participation Points      5 points per tournament**

**Points are given to only those participants that qualify as a South Sound Youth All Star. Those points earned by bowlers outside of the South Sound Association go unearned.**

2 <sup>nd</sup> place – Seattle Bowler	45 pts (void – unearned)
3 <sup>rd</sup> place – Portland Bowler	40 pts (void – unearned)
4 <sup>th</sup> place – South Sound Bowler	35 pts
5 <sup>th</sup> place – South Sound Bowler	30 pts
6 <sup>th</sup> – 10 <sup>th</sup> place – South Sound Bowler	20 pts (not moved up)
11 <sup>th</sup> – 16 <sup>th</sup> place – SS Bowler	10 pts (not moved up)
